

## **Who can attend the group?**

- Any Ledbury and District u3a member may attend the group.
- A non u3a member may attend once, to decide if they wish to join the u3a. The Groups Co-ordinator and/or the Membership Secretary should be informed as soon as possible if a non U3A member attends your group. Offer a non U3A member an application form.
- A member of a different Cotswold Link u3a (i.e. all u3as in Herefordshire, Worcestershire and Gloucestershire) may attend one group in Ledbury & District u3a, without paying a joining fee. The Groups Co-ordinator and/or the Membership Secretary should be informed if you have members of other U3As attending your group and the register should state the U3A of which they are a member. They still pay the Ledbury u3a meeting fee.
- A member who cannot participate without assistance may bring a carer. The carer need not be a u3a member and does not pay a fee. The Groups Co-ordinator and/or the Membership Secretary should be informed.
- The maximum number in the group may be determined by many factors (most commonly the space in the venue), but members should not be refused for personal reasons.
- If the group is full, the names of interested people who cannot be accommodated should be forwarded to the Groups Co-ordinator. When there is sufficient interest, a second group may be formed with a new leader or a leader from the existing group.
